



Hazel Oak School Sports Premium Funding 2017 – 2018

Purpose of the Funding

The Government is giving funding to schools for a specific purpose. Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this. Hazel Oak's Sports Premium funding for 2016-2017 is £16,600.

Possible uses for the funding might include:

- Supporting and engaging the least active children through new or additional Change4Life clubs
- Paying for professional development opportunities for teachers in PE and sport
- Providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE and sport
- Running sport competitions, or increasing pupils' participation in the School Games
- Buying quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE and sport
- Providing places for pupils on after school sports clubs and holiday clubs
- Pooling the additional funding with that of other local schools.

Below is a breakdown of Hazel Oak's Primary Sports Premium Plan for the Academic Year 2017-2018 and its expected impact.

Expenditure	Item / Service	Impact
£1460	Solihull School Sports Partnership Membership	Students will take part in a range of extra curricular events such as the South Solihull Dance Festival at Alderbrook School, Chance To Shine 6 week cricket coaching for Y6 from WCC and entry to South Solihull Cricket Festival. The PE coordinator is able to attend training sessions led jointly by Solihull

		SSP and Youth Sport Trust and we have Youth Sport Trust membership for 1 year.
£500	Conferences and Training	This money has been allocated for the PE co-ordinator and teachers to attend any relevant conferences and training updates relating to our primary PE provision.
£700	Cover for teachers.	Hazel Oak teachers are able to attend training sessions to develop their teaching skills and confidence in PE, leading to high quality teaching and learning. Cover will be provided by qualified teachers to allow this to happen.
£3000	Additional resources for the development of Balanceability	Purchase of 15 x additional balance bikes and resources so that Balanceability can be extended into classes Socrates and Confucius. Purchase of additional helmets to fit KS2 children and replace broken ones.
£1500	Shed for storage of Balanceability equipment and bikes	A large storage shed and appropriate brackets etc. need to be purchased for the sustainability of Balanceability. This will ensure that the bikes and resources are stored effectively, are easy to access and are not damaged. The bikes will be maintained by the site assistant and members of the school's sixth form.
£1000	Balanceability Training	Teachers who are new to KS1/2 will be trained as Balanceability leaders and provided with the appropriate training materials to support teaching and learning.
£8000	Playground Development	The playground is going to be developed to support physical activity at playtimes. This will include a bike track and other features to support and encourage physical development/fitness.
£440	Outdoor Resources	We are going to purchase a range of new balls and other resources to develop and encourage active, outdoor play.
