



Hazel Oak School Sports Premium Funding 2015 – 2016.

Purpose of the Funding

The Government is giving funding to schools for a specific purpose. Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this. Hazel Oak's Sports Premium funding for 2015-2016 was £8,240.

Possible uses for the funding might include:

- Supporting and engaging the least active children through new or additional Change4Life clubs
- Paying for professional development opportunities for teachers in PE and sport
- Providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE and sport
- Running sport competitions, or increasing pupils' participation in the School Games
- Buying quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE and sport
- Providing places for pupils on after school sports clubs and holiday clubs
- Pooling the additional funding with that of other local schools.

Below is a breakdown of Hazel Oak's Primary Sports Premium spending last academic year and the impact that this had.

Expenditure	Item / Service	Impact
£1,260	Solihull School Sports Partnership Membership	Students were able to take part in a range of extra curricular events such as the South Solihull Dance Festival at Alderbrook School, Chance To Shine 6 week cricket coaching for Y6 from WCC and entry to South Solihull Cricket Festival. PE Co-ordinator attended 3 training sessions led jointly by Solihull SSP and Youth Sport Trust. Youth Sport Trust membership for 1 year. 2 members of staff attended an Inclusion in PE training day and have adapted their practice to ensure better inclusive lessons for all pupils at Hazel Oak.
£100	Katie Driscoll Dance Kompany – Termly Dance DVD's	New DVD's received once a term from a recognised educational dance teacher to expand the range of 'Wake Up Shake Up' dances for the Lower School pupils to take part in each morning before school. All pupils take part

		<p>in a 10 minute warm up routine in the hall, together with staff, which has helped to energise the students ready for the day. Many pupils have had a long bus journey to school and sitting still in a small space is not comfortable for them. This allows them the chance to get moving, use some stored energy and release positive hormones ready to start the day. Pupils really enjoy these sessions and ask to do them at other times too!</p>
£108	Skills 2 Play Resource cards.	<p>A set of resource cards for teachers to use in lessons to develop a range of multi skill activities. The cards are also suitable for more able pupils to use to challenge themselves to develop a skill in a different and fun ways. These cards have supported our aim of developing mastery of skills in different physical activities as many of our students require a lengthier timescale to acquire skills, including the more complicated skill of applying the actions in different situations.</p>
£20	Warwickshire Cricket Club – Teacher’s Course	<p>PE teacher attended a full day training course to develop the skills to teach the basic skills for cricket, including how to coach and umpire the games. Students were then able to receive higher quality teaching in their PE lessons across school and the Y6 pupils were better prepared for the Festival in which they took part.</p>
£6,752 (Total Cost £13,674)	Purchase and Installation of Trim Trail	<p>Pupils now access the trim trail on a daily basis as part of their ‘Fitness Flash’ each morning, having a positive impact on pupil fitness levels.</p>
