

Thank you for helping us to manage moving safely around the school site. We are adapting our system as we go and as more pupils return, to make sure things run as smoothly as possible.

Arrival and departure

Please aim to arrive for the start and end of day routines, as closely as you can to your set times.

Earlier buses will need to wait in the car park with pupils on board until staff ask them to unload. Escorts should accompany pupils between the tyres and cones to the playground gate at the front. Then exit through the one way system.

All buses and family cars must arrive on Hazeloak Road from the Burman Road end and when leaving turn left only towards Hurdis Road.

Pedestrians will be admitted at the arrival time (either 8.50 or 9.15) at the main gate. If you arrive early please wait in cars or away from the gates to prevent crowding and maintain social distancing. If traffic means you arrive before time, please consider parking away from the immediate areas.

Movement on site

Please follow yellow signs and staff directions to keep within the one way system. With lots of people traffic we need to ask parents to drop off and move on as quickly as possible at the start and end of the day.

Our greatest challenge is due to having a single access point. With pedestrians coming in and out of the same gate, please take care to leave plenty of space between you as you come in and be wary of two way traffic at this point.

Parking reminder

We are always keen to work with our neighbours on Hazeloak Road and would ask all drivers, families and visitors to park sensitively and not to park on or block driveways. If possible parking away at the ends of the road or on adjacent roads is a big help to prevent congestion. This also makes drop offs and pick ups much quicker for everyone.

This is also why we ask that all those driving onsite, buses, taxis and cars, arrive from the Burman Road end of Hazeloak Road and leave by one only turning left. The reduced congestion also helps to safeguard our pupils and pedestrians.

It was great to start welcoming you all back today, we have really missed you! Thanks for your help with this and do let me know if you notice any hot spots or things we can improve on with these systems. Don't forget we are only taking in half classes until Wednesday next week.
