

## SCHOOL ACTIONS – COVID 19

**Pupil / Staff member** is symptomatic:

- A high temperature
- A new persistent cough
- A loss of taste / smell

**Pupil / Staff member** to go home immediately. *Move to isolation rooms until able to leave or collected.*

All people in their household to **self isolate** with them immediately.

Test arranged – school can help organise a test for pupil

All other staff and pupil to remain in school at this stage.

Test results

### **Positive**

- Solihull Council Public Health/ Public Health England direct school actions.
- Bubble will close for 14 days from last contact, your child will need to **self isolate**– School will inform you of the return date.

### **Negative**

- No impact on other pupils and staff.
- Pupil / staff member can return to school when well enough.

**Self isolate** – this means that you must not leave your house other than to go to take a test if you need to have one. If the whole household is isolating, then you need to arrange for food deliveries etc. as you cannot go out to the shops. You cannot go to the park, to visit other people and other people cannot visit you. **You must stay at home to prevent the spread of the virus.**
